**MINUTES OF THE 18TH REGULAR SESSION OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD
(15th CITY COUNCIL) OF PAGADIAN CITY HELD ON 26 NOVEMBER 2025 AT THE SP
SESSION HALL, 4th FLOOR CITY COMMERCIAL CENTER (C3) BUILDING,
PAGADIAN CITY**

CALL TO ORDER:

Honorable Maphilindo Q. Obaob, Chairman Pro Tempore, convened and officially called to order the 18th Regular Session of the 15th City Council at 9:23 in the morning.

**INVOCATION, SINGING OF THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL ANTHEM AND
RECITATION OF THE “PANUNUMPA SA WATAWAT NG PILIPINAS:**

Upon motion of the Floor Leader, Honorable Jackielyn Krystyl C. Bana, the session, accompanied by a prepared audio recording, commenced with the invocation, which was then followed by the mass singing of the Philippine National Anthem, the recitation of the “Panunumpa sa Watawat ng Pilipinas,” the singing of the “Zamboanga del Sur March,” and the “Pagadian City Hymn.”

ROLL CALL AND DETERMINATION OF QUORUM:

A roll call was made at the direction of the Chair and quorum was declared with the attendance of eight (8) Council Members namely: Honorable Roger L. Acedillo, Honorable Jackielyn Krystyl C. Bana, Honorable Ma. Alicia Elena V. Ariosa, Honorable Maphilindo Q. Obaob, Honorable Lance Samuel F. Co, Honorable Bienvenido C. Culve, Honorable Ronald Christopher Glenn L. Ariosa, and Honorable Marylynn U. Tan.

Sometime later on during the course of the proceeding, the presence of Honorable Patrisha Kaye N. Asugas, Honorable Ariel J. Lim, Jr., and Honorable Ann Marjorie N. Revelo, were recorded as acknowledged by the Chair. The body also noted that Honorable Vice Mayor Monique Shaira Y. To and Honorable Joan Szanne S. Pulmones were both out on Official Business.

READING AND APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF THE 17TH REGULAR SESSION:

At the instance of the Jackielyn Krystyl C. Bana, the body dispensed with the Reading of the Minutes of the 17th Regular Session which was held on November 19, 2025. Thereafter, with the presentation of a formal motion for its adoption and, with no discussions from the floor, the minutes was approved as presented.

FIRST READING & REFERRAL TO COMMITTEES:

The herein items calendared for First Reading and Referral to Committees were then taken up and acted upon accordingly, to wit:

1. Appropriation Ordinance No. 03, s. 2025 (Supplemental Budget No. 2) of Barangay Balintawak, involving an appropriation of Nine Hundred Thousand Pesos (P900,000.00) was referred to the Committee on Finance & Appropriations.
2. A joint referral was made for Barangay Ordinance No. 2025-01, S. 2025 from the Barangay Council of Kalasan, entitled: “An Ordinance Prohibiting Minors from operating motor vehicle and imposing speed limits within the

jurisdiction of Barangay Kalasan,” to the Committee on Barangay Affairs and Committee on Police, Fire & Public Safety.

3. The following Barangay Ordinances were referred to the Committee on Barangay Affairs, viz:
 - Barangay Ordinance No. 2025-02, S. 2025 from the Barangay Council of Kalasan, entitled: “An Ordinance Prohibiting Obstruction Of Roads, Alleys And Other Spaces Within Barangay Kalasan And Providing Penalties For Violation Thereof.”
 - Barangay Ordinance No. 2023-01, S. 2023 from the Barangay Council of Kalasan, entitled: “An Ordinance Establishing a unified/standard Barangay Clearance Fee and Other Barangay Fees or Charges.”
4. The endorsed Draft Ordinance No. 027, authored by Honorable Lance Samuel F. Co, entitled: “An Ordinance Approving the Temporary Closure to Vehicular Traffic of a portion of the Western lane of F.S. Pajares Avenue from the corners of V. Sagun Street and P.L. Urro Street as well as the sidewalk and parking area of a portion of P.L. Urro Street (particularly fronting the San Jose Parish Church) from the corners of B. Aquino Street and F.S. Pajares Avenue for a specific period from December 1, 2025 to January 18, 2026, in connection with the city’s celebration of the “Paskuhan 2025 and the forthcoming “Pasalamat Festival 2026” was next considered.

Following a brief recess to allow the body to discuss the matter informally and, upon resumption at 9:40 a. m., the matter was considered urgent due to the proximity of the requested period. Subsequently, the body, after a short deliberation and at the instance of Honorable Culve and duly seconded, resolved to approve Draft Ordinance No. 027 on First Reading and for its consideration on Second Reading through **Resolution No. 2025-0159**.

At this point, a one-minute recess was then declared. Upon resumption, a lengthy discussion ensued after the motion of Honorable Culve and duly seconded to approve Draft Ordinance No. 027 on Second Reading.

During the discussion, Honorable Lim, Jr. presented his concerns on the matter particularly the guidelines on the number and selection process of applicant–stall lessees’ as he relayed complaints during the previous years where an applicant had been replaced by a new applicant; and the rental rate considering that there were reports that the stalls were being sub-leased for a higher rate. Also, he inquired the matter relative to the approved traffic flow plan considering that there is now a Robinson Mall which will contribute to the traffic congestion. In response thereto, the author, Honorable Co, manifested that there are at least 60 food stalls available in the food street and only applicants with legitimate food establishments are being considered taking into account their previous operation. Honorable Co likewise contended that sub-leasing is strictly prohibited and the standard rental rate is P15,000.00 for the whole duration of the festivities. As regards to the traffic flow, he stressed that currently the eastern side of the F.S. Pajares Avenue is a two-way traffic, however, there will be an adjustment in the traffic flow as soon as it will be found necessary. Accordingly, Honorable Co assured the body that the manifestation of Honorable Lim, Jr is well taken and seriously considered particularly the inclusion of the Business Permit and Licensing Office (BPLO) and the City Health Office in the selection committee. Furthermore, Honorable Co, in his capacity as the Chairperson of the

Paskuhan Committee 2025, informed the body that concerns on sanitation and cleanliness, given that the activity is dealing with food, is seriously taken into consideration, as he further contended that the staff/servers of the awarded stall applicants will undergo a seminar/briefing on sanitation and proper handling of food to prevent incidence of food poisoning.

Honorable Revelo, on the other hand, sought clarification whether the sidewalk along the Robinsons Mall will be used for display of goods and merchandise such as toys which, accordingly, will pose traffic hazard in the area, to which Honorable Co categorically replied that there is no plan to use the area for display of goods. Honorable Co, in response to the queries posed by Honorable Culve, contended that the food street will open from 3:00 P.M. to 12 midnight, and no person from the awarded stalls-owners shall be allowed to stay after operating hours as the area will be closed off to everyone except the security personnel who will be roaming around. Also, he averred that each stall is required to put up signages of the establishment's name and provide fire extinguishers.

With no further discussion, the body supported the motion of Honorable Culve through the passage of **Resolution No. 2025-0160**, approving Draft Ordinance No. 027, entitled: "An Ordinance Approving the Temporary Closure to Vehicular Traffic of a portion of the Western lane of F.S. Pajares Avenue from the corners of V. Sagun Street and P.L. Urro Street as well as the sidewalk and parking area of a portion of P.L. Urro Street (particularly fronting the San Jose Parish Church) from the corners of B. Aquino Street and F.S. Pajares Avenue for a specific period from December 1, 2025 to January 18, 2026, in connection with the city's celebration of the "Paskuhan 2025 and the forthcoming "Pasalamat Festival 2026," on Second Reading and for further consideration on Third Reading.

A one-minute recess was then declared. Upon resumption, the motion of Honorable Culve and duly seconded facilitated the adoption of **Resolution No. 2025-0161**, approving Draft Ordinance No. 027 on Third Reading and ordaining the same as **City Ordinance No. 2025-618**.

5. SK Resolution No. 25, s. 2025, entitled: "A resolution approving the Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) Supplemental Budget No. 01, of Barangay Balintawak, Pagadian City for the Priority Programs, Projects, and Activities (PPA's) related to sports development activities" was referred to the Committee on Finance & Appropriations.
6. The copy furnished Order from the National Water Resources Board (NWRB), relative to the scheduled hearing on the Application of PAMANA Water Corporation for a Certificate of Public Convenience, is hereby reset to November 25, 2025 at 9:00 o'clock in the morning at the NWRB-WUD Conference Room, 8th Floor NIA Building, EDSA, Quezon City, was deemed noted and filed.
7. Likewise, the letter-reply from General Manager Pericles C. Sollano and Mr. Lamberto F. Talip, Jr., Chairman–Board of Director, Pagadian City Water District (PCWD), dated 18 November 2025, in response to the 15th City Council Resolution No. 2025-0142, with an attached PCWD–Board Resolution No. 135-25 which, in gist, requested the Sangguniang Panlungsod to re-schedule the invitation for the reason that the Board of Directors are not available during the scheduled session on November 26 due to a prior scheduled official travel

to Valencia City, Bukidnon, to attend the “2025 Mindanao Association of Water Districts, Incorporated (MAWD) Forum” was deemed noted and to be put on file. Along with this action, the Secretary to the Sangguniang Panlungsod was directed to extend anew an invitation to the Board of Directors of the Pagadian City Water District (PCWD) to attend the 19th Regular Session of the body on December 10, 2025.

8. At this juncture, the following resolutions from the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Zamboanga del Sur were deemed noted and to be put on file, viz:

- Resolution No. 12-399-2025 from the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Zamboanga del Sur, entitled: “Declaring Valid City Ordinance No. 2025-610 dated September 24, 2025, titled: “An Ordinance Prescribing Regulations in Addressing and Abating Nuisances including noise pollution in the City of Pagadian.
- Resolution No. 12-402-2025 from the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Zamboanga del Sur, entitled: “Adopting the Findings and recommendation embodied in Joint Committee Report No. 242-2025 dated 29 October 2025 of the Committee on Trade and Industry and the Committee on Rules, Laws and Privileges, thereby declaring valid City Ordinance No. 2025-609 dated 3 September 2025 of Pagadian City, Zamboanga del Sur, entitled: “An Ordinance Establishing The Local Economic Development and Investment Promotion Center-Pagadian City, under the Office of the City Mayor, Defining its functions, and setting the appropriation funds thereof.”

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

The body unanimously approved the consideration of the herein Committee Reports, and the recommendations contained therein were acted upon as recorded herein, as follows:

- 1) Committee Report No. 054 from the Committee on Good Government, Ethics and Civil Service, as presented by Honorable Bana, for Referral No. 15cc-0081 facilitated the passage of **Resolution No. 2025-0162**, concurring and affirming the reconstitution of the Personnel Selection/Promotion Board of the City Government of Pagadian, as enunciated under Executive Order No. 10, series of 2025, issued by Honorable City Mayor Samuel S. Co.
- 2) Joint Committee Report No. 067 from the Committee on Laws, Rules and Policy Formulation and Committee on Planning and Landed Estates, as reported by Honorable Bana, for Referral No. 15cc-0037, led to the adoption of **Resolution No. 2025-0163**, authorizing the Honorable City Mayor to execute and sign, for and in behalf of the City Government of Pagadian, a Deed of Exchange involving a City Government-owned parcel of land known as Lot No. 1, Block 40, containing an area of 5,500 square meters, located near the Regional Center, Barangay Balintawak, this city, and a privately-owned parcel of land known as Lot No. 5881-L-2-B, PSD-09-062509, covered by TCT No. T-45,628, registered in the name of Ms. Julieta N. Paller, containing an area of 5,212 square meters, located within the 80-hectare Regional Center Site in Barangay Balintawak, Pagadian City.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

At this point, the consideration of the concern of the Honorable Members of the 15th City Council pertaining to the Performance Evaluation Report of PAMANA Water Corporation was recalendared to the next session on December 10, 2025.

BUSINESS OF THE DAY (MATTERS FOR SECOND READING):

At this juncture, the body Proceeded with the consideration of the Matter under Business of the Day (Matters for Second Reading), pertaining to Draft Ordinance No. 020, authored by Honorable Lance Samuel F. Co, entitled: “An Ordinance Creating The City Disaster Risk Reduction And Management Office Of The City Of Pagadian, Adopting Its Organizational Structure With Corresponding Positions And Staffing Pattern And Providing The Necessary Funds Therefor And For Other Purposes.”

Upon resumption after a brief recess, since the suggested amendments were already incorporated, on motion of Honorable Co and duly seconded, the body approved Draft Ordinance No. 020 on Second Reading and for its consideration on Third Reading through **Resolution No. 2025-0164**.

After a recess was declared, upon formal motion of Honorable Co and duly seconded, the body adopted **Resolution No. 2025-0165**, approving Draft Ordinance No. 020 on Third Reading and ordaining the same as **City Ordinance 2025-619**, entitled: “An Ordinance Creating The City Disaster Risk Reduction And Management Office Of The City Of Pagadian, Adopting Its Organizational Structure With Corresponding Positions And Staffing Pattern And Providing The Necessary Funds Therefor And For Other Purposes.”

OTHER MATTERS:

At this point, the herein actions were recorded as unanimously adopted by the body to officially dispose of the items calendared under Other Matters, to wit:

1. The endorsed letter-invitation from PCL-ZDS Federation President, Honorable Jackielyn Krystyl C. Bana, re: Capacity-Building Seminar on Parliamentary Rules, Legislative Ethics, and Leadership Excellence; Provincial Local Legislative Awards and Year-End Assembly on December 10-12, 2025 at Pavilion Hall, Provincial Government Complex, Dao, Pagadian City, Zamboanga del Sur was deemed noted and filed.
2. A joint referral was made for the endorsed letter of Executive Judge Romeo T. Descallar of the Regional Trial Court Ninth Judicial Region, respectfully requesting for a monthly allowance of Five Thousand (P5,000.00) Pesos for each of the Clerks of Court and Branch Clerks of Courts, with a request of the Honorable City Mayor for an authority to grant the said allowance to the Committee on Laws, Rules & Policy Formulation and Committee on Finance & Appropriations.
3. Committee Report No. 068 from the Committee on Barangay Affairs, was presented by Honorable Marylynn U. Tan, for Referral No. 15cc-0119. After the Honorable Revelo requested verification on when was the matter referred, a brief recess was declared. Upon resumption, the recommendation of the Committee led to the approval of **Resolution No. 2025-0166**, remanding, without action, to the Barangay Council of Bulatok, this city, its Barangay Ordinance No. 02, s. 2025 entitled: “An Ordinance Prohibiting The Rental Of

Bicycles To Minors For Safety Purpose And Imposing Penalties For Violation Thereof, with an advise to institute amendments thereto to conform with the findings and recommendations specified in Committee Report No. 068 of the Committee on Barangay Affairs.

4. Committee Report No. 069 from the Committee on Barangay Affairs, as reported by Honorable Tan, for Referral No. 15cc-0120, led to the passage of **Resolution No. 2025-0167**, remanding, without action, to the Barangay Council of Bulatok, this city, its Barangay Ordinance No. 04, s. 2025 entitled: “An Ordinance implementing penalties for causing commotion during barangay-funded activities in Barangay Bulatok,” with an advice to institute amendments thereto to conform with the findings and recommendations specified in Committee Report No. 069 of the Committee on Barangay Affairs.
5. Committee Report No. 070 from the Committee on Barangay Affairs, as presented by Honorable Tan, for Referral No. 15cc-0121, facilitated the approval of **Resolution No. 2025-0168**, remanding, without action, to the Barangay Council of Bulatok, this city, its Barangay Ordinance No. 05, s. 2025 entitled: “An Ordinance implementing curfew hours for minors and imposing penalties for violation thereof in Barangay Bulatok, Pagadian City,” with an advice to institute amendments thereto to conform with the findings and recommendations specified in Committee Report No. 070 of the Committee on Barangay Affairs.
6. For Joint Committee Report No. 071 from the Committee on Barangay Affairs & Committee on Laws, Rules, and Policy Formulation, as reported by Honorable Tan, for Referral No. 15cc-0129, the body, in support of the Committee’s recommendation, approved **Resolution No. 2025-0169**, remanding, without action, to the Barangay Council of Bulatok, this city, its Barangay Ordinance No. 03, s. 2025 entitled: “An Ordinance requiring the settlement of all pending barangay level cases before the issuance of any barangay certification, clearance, or documents,” with an advice to institute amendments thereto to conform with the findings and recommendations specified in Joint Committee Report No. 071 of the Committees on Barangay Affairs and on Laws, Rules and Policy Formulation.
7. Committee Report No. 072 from the Committee on Good Government, Ethics & Civil Service, as presented by Honorable Bana, for Referral No. 15cc-0125 was next considered. The body, following a short deliberation and, upon her formal motion and duly seconded, adopted **Resolution No. 2025-0170**, approving on Second Reading Draft Ordinance No. 023, authored by Honorable Lance Samuel F. Co, entitled: “An Ordinance Creating the Public Employment Service Office “PESO” as a Department of the City Government of Pagadian, Defining its Duties, Functions and Responsibilities and Appropriating Funds Therefor and Other Purposes,” and for its consideration on Third Reading.

Upon resumption after a one-minute recess, the motion of Honorable Bana and duly seconded, led to the adoption of **Resolution No. 2025-0171**, approving Draft Ordinance No. 023 on Third Reading and ordaining the same as **City Ordinance No. 2025-620**.

8. Committee Report No. 073 from the Committee on Good Government, Ethics & Civil Service, as presented by Honorable Bana, for Referral No. 15cc-0124 pertaining to Draft Ordinance No. 022, authored by Honorable Lance Samuel F.

Co, entitled: “An Ordinance Creating the Human Resource and Development Office (HRMO) as a Department of the City Government of Pagadian, Adopting its Present and Existing Organizational Structure, Defining its Duties, Functions and Responsibilities and Appropriating Funds Therefor and Other Purposes,” following a brief discussion, the body, upon her formal motion and duly seconded, resolved to approve Draft Ordinance No. 022 on Second Reading and for its consideration on Third Reading through **Resolution No. 2025-0172**.

A one-minute recess was then declared. Upon resumption, the motion of Honorable Bana facilitated the adoption of **Resolution No. 2025-0173**, approving Draft Ordinance No. 022 on Third Reading and ordaining the same as **City Ordinance No. 2025-621**.

9. Joint Committee Report No. 074 from the Committee on Planning and Landed Estates and Committee on Laws, Rules & Policy Formulation, as presented by Honorable Ariel J. Lim Jr., for Referral No. 15cc-0090 led to the adoption of **Resolution No. 2025-0174**, authorizing the Honorable City Mayor to execute and sign, for and in behalf of the City Government of Pagadian, a Deed of Exchange involving a City Government-owned parcel of land known as Lot No. 4823-b, Pls-119, Psd-9-097582, covered by TCT No. T-5,875, containing an area of 10,000 square meters, located at Barangay Balintawak, Pagadian City, and a privately-owned parcel of land known as Lot No. 5210-a-10, BSD-0-002212-AR/VLT, covered by TCT No. E-1593, registered in the name of Blue Shark Development and Trading Corporation, with an area of 9,291 square meters, located within the 80-hectare Regional Center Site in Barangay Balintawak, Pagadian City.

At this point, Honorable Obaob relinquished the Chair to Honorable Lim, Jr. to allow him to render his report.

10. Next considered was Committee Report No. 075 from the Oversight Committee, as presented by Honorable Obaob, for Referral No. 15cc-0107. Based on the recommendation of the concerned Committee, the letter-reply of the Office of the City Mayor pertaining to SP Resolution Nos. 2025-0037, entitled: “A Resolution requesting the Honorable City Mayor to conduct comprehensive evaluation on the implementation of City Ordinance No. 2024-573, entitled: “An Ordinance creating the Pagadian City Sports Development Office (PSDO), under the office of the city mayor, providing its personnel and composition, defining their duties, functions and responsibilities, and for other purposes,” and direct the following offices specified hereunder to do and perform the following acts and things; and Resolution No. 2025-0038, entitled: “A Resolution requesting the Honorable City Mayor to conduct comprehensive evaluation on the implementation of City Ordinance No. 2022-519, entitled: “An Ordinance promulgating the guidelines on the grant of monetary incentives to any individual, pair, group or team, including their respective coaches or trainers, who have been declared and ranked within the top three (3) winners of any sports, skills, arts and academic competitions in the regional, national and international events and appropriating funds therefor,” as amended by City Ordinance No. 2024-574, and direct the following offices specified hereunder to do and perform the following acts and things,” was referred to the Committee on Games, Amusements and Sports for further review and evaluation.

UNSCHEDULED MATTERS:

At this juncture, the body then proceeded to tackle the individual concerns of the Council Members under Unscheduled Matters, these were then accorded actions as herein recorded, to wit:

- 1) On the query posed by Honorable Revelo relative to the status of Draft Ordinance No. 004 which was jointly referred to the Committee on Youth, Juvenile Delinquency and Drug-Abuse Prevention and Committee on Education, Science & Technology & Accreditation of NGOs and POs last July 09, 2025. After a brief recess to allow the body to discuss the matter informally, Honorable Tan–in her capacity as the Chairperson of the Committee on Youth, Juvenile Delinquency and Drug-Abuse Prevention, gave assurance that she will make a report on the matter in the next session.
- 2) Honorable Culve, for his part, presented the issue pertaining to the provision of City Ordinance No. 2018-400, particularly Section 216 thereof, which concerns the “Collection–Sharing Scheme” provision under the administrative and judicial fines. Thereafter, Honorable Revelo, in support of the manifestation of Honorable Culve, gave details of the scheme.

At this juncture, the body, after a brief recess and upon resumption, resolved to extend an invitation-letter addressed to the City Treasurer through the Honorable City Mayor to attend the 19th Regular Session of the Sangguniang Panlungsod on December 10, 2025 at the SP Session Hall, 4th floor, City Commercial Center (C3), Barangay Santiago, this city, purposely to provide information on the implementation of the said provision from the years 2018 up to 2024 and to give a report on the total collection and the apportionment for the years 2018 up to 2024.

- 3) The Honorable Floor Leader, in consideration of the passage of City Ordinance No. 2025-611, entitled: “An Ordinance Promulgating the Internal Rules of Procedure of the 15th City Council of Pagadian,” presented her proposal for the reorganization and reconstitution of the 15th City Council’s officer positions as well as the different Chairpersons of the standing committees. Following a short deliberation, the body, upon her formal motion and duly seconded, adopted the following resolutions, to wit:
 - **Resolution No. 2025-0175**, declaring as vacant all Officer Positions as well as all the Chairmanship of the different standing committees of the Sangguniang Panlungsod (15th City Council) of Pagadian City.
 - **Resolution No. 2025-0176**, approving the nomination and election of the new officers and the different committee chairmanships of the standing committees of the Sangguniang Panlungsod (15th City Council) of Pagadian City, to wit:
