**MINUTES OF THE 21ST REGULAR SESSION OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD
(15th CITY COUNCIL) OF PAGADIAN CITY HELD ON 14 JANUARY 2026 AT THE SP
SESSION HALL, 4th FLOOR CITY COMMERCIAL CENTER (C3) BUILDING, PAGADIAN
CITY**

CALL TO ORDER:

Honorable Vice Mayor Monique Shaira Y. To, Presiding Officer, convened and officially called to order the 21st Regular Session of the 15th City Council at 9:31 in the morning.

**INVOCATION, SINGING OF THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL ANTHEM AND
RECITATION OF THE “PANUNUMPA SA WATAWAT NG PILIPINAS:**

Upon motion of the Floor Leader, Honorable Jackielyn Krystyl C. Bana, the session, accompanied by a prepared audio recording, commenced with the invocation, followed thereafter by the mass singing of the Philippine National Anthem, the recitation of the “Panunumpa sa Watawat ng Pilipinas,” the singing of both the “Zamboanga del Sur March” and the “Pagadian City Hymn.”

ROLL CALL AND DETERMINATION OF QUORUM:

A roll call was made at the direction of the Chair and quorum was then declared with the attendance of eight (8) Council Members namely: Honorable Vice Mayor Monique Shaira Y. To, Honorable Roger L. Acedillo, Honorable Jackielyn Krystyl C. Bana, Honorable Maphilindo Q. Obaob, Honorable Bienvenido C. Culve, Honorable Ronald Christopher Glenn L. Ariosa, Honorable Joan Szanne S. Pulmones and Honorable Marylynn U. Tan.

Sometime later on during the course of the proceeding, the presence of Honorable Patrisha Kaye N. Asugas and Honorable Lance Samuel F. Co, was recorded. The body also noted that Honorable Ariel J. Lim, Jr., Honorable Ma. Alicia Elena V. Ariosa, and Honorable Ann Marjorie N. Revelo were all on leave.

READING AND APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF THE 20th REGULAR SESSION:

At the instance of the Honorable Floor Leader, the body dispensed with the Reading of the Minutes of the 20th Regular Session held on January 07, 2026. Thereafter, with the presentation of a formal motion for its adoption and there being no comments or discussions from the floor, the minutes was approved as presented.

FIRST READING & REFERRAL TO COMMITTEES:

The herein items calendared for First Reading and Referral to Committees were then taken up and acted upon accordingly, to wit:

1. First taken up was Appropriation Ordinance No. 01, s. 2026 (Annual Budget) of Barangay Lison Valley, involving an appropriation of Six Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (P6,500,000.00) which was referred to the Committee on Finance & Appropriations.
2. For the endorsed request from Rev. Fr. Miguel D. Cahanap, Cathedral Administrator and Chairperson of the Fiesta Executive Council 2026, requesting for the temporary closure of road to vehicular traffic along J. Ariosa Street, from corner Cabrera Street to corner Sanson Street, on the following dates and times: January 9 to 16, 2026, from 1:00 PM to 10:00 PM,

and January 17 to 18, 2026, from 1:00 PM until 12:00 midnight, in connection with activities relative to the Fiesta celebration, w the body, on motion of Honorable Ronald Christopher Glenn L. Ariosa and duly seconded, resolved to treat the matter as urgent and the rules were then suspended.

Following a brief deliberation and given the importance and urgency of the foregoing matter, the body supported the seconded motion of Honorable Ronald Christopher Glenn L. Ariosa to approve on First Reading Draft Ordinance No. 028, entitled: “An Ordinance Approving the Temporary Closure to Vehicular Traffic of Governor J. Ariosa Street Specifically (Fronting Santo Niño Cathedral) from corners Cabrera and Sanson Streets, During the following Dates and Time, to wit: January 9—16, 2026, from 1:00 O’clock in the afternoon up to 10:00 O’clock in the Evening, and January 17 to 18, 2026, from 1:00 O’clock in the afternoon up to 12:00 O’clock Midnight, in connection with the weeklong celebration of the Annual Feast of Señor Santo Niño,” and for its consideration on Second Reading through the passage of **Resolution No. 2026-0222**.

A one-minute recess was then declared and, upon resumption, the body, on formal motion of Honorable Ronald Christopher Glenn L. Ariosa and duly seconded, passed **Resolution No. 2026-0223**, approving on Second Reading Draft Ordinance No. 028 and for its consideration on Third Reading.

Likewise, a recess was declared by the Chair and, upon resumption, the body, at the instance of Honorable Ronald Christopher Glenn L. Ariosa and duly seconded, adopted **Resolution No. 2026-0224**, approving on Third and Final Reading Draft Ordinance No. 028 and ordaining the same as **City Ordinance No. 2026-624**, entitled: “An Ordinance Approving the Temporary Closure to Vehicular Traffic of Governor J. Ariosa Street Specifically (Fronting Santo Niño Cathedral) from corners Cabrera and Sanson Streets, During the following Dates and Time, to wit: January 9—16, 2026, from 1:00 O’clock in the afternoon up to 10:00 O’clock in the Evening, and January 17 to 18, 2026, from 1:00 O’clock in the afternoon up to 12:00 O’clock Midnight, in connection with the weeklong celebration of the Annual Feast of Señor Santo Niño.”

UNSCHEDULED MATTERS:

At this juncture, the body considered under Unscheduled Matters the lone item particularly Appropriation Ordinance No. 01, s. 2026 (Annual Budget) of Barangay Dao, involving an appropriation of Twelve Million Pesos (P12,000,000.00), and subsequently referred the same to the Committee on Finance & Appropriations.

At this point, the Chair declared a recess.

Upon resumption at 10:09 a.m., Honorable Culve now assumed the floor leadership as Honorable Bana had asked to be excused due to an important engagement.

ADJOURNMENT:

With no more matters to discuss, the session was declared adjourned on motion of Honorable Culve, following the closing prayer led by Honorable Asugas.
