MINUTES OF THE 22ND REGULAR SESSION OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD (15th CITY COUNCIL) OF PAGADIAN CITY HELD ON 21 JANUARY 2026 AT THE SP SESSION HALL, 4th FLOOR CITY COMMERCIAL CENTER (C3) BUILDING, PAGADIAN CITY

CALL TO ORDER:

Honorable Vice Mayor Monique Shaira Y. To, Presiding Officer, convened and officially called to order the 22nd Regular Session of the 15th City Council at 9:18 in the morning.

INVOCATION, SINGING OF THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL ANTHEM AND RECITATION OF THE “PANUNUMPA SA WATAWAT NG PILIPINAS:

Upon motion of the Floor Leader, Honorable Jackielyn Krystyl C. Bana, the session, accompanied by a prepared audio recording, commenced with the invocation, followed thereafter by the mass singing of the Philippine National Anthem, the recitation of the “Panunumpa sa Watawat ng Pilipinas,” the singing of both the “Zamboanga del Sur March” and the “Pagadian City Hymn.”

ROLL CALL AND DETERMINATION OF QUORUM:

A roll call was made at the direction of the Chair and quorum was then declared with the attendance of eight (8) Council Members namely: Honorable Vice Mayor Monique Shaira Y. To, Honorable Jackielyn Krystyl C. Bana, Honorable Ma. Alicia Elena V. Ariosa, Honorable Bienvenido C. Culve, Honorable Ronald Christopher Glenn L. Ariosa, Honorable Ann Marjorie N. Revelo, Honorable Joan Szanne S. Pulmones, and Honorable Marylynn U. Tan.

Sometime later on during the course of the proceeding, the presence of Honorable Maphilindo Q. Obaob, Honorable Lance Samuel F. Co, Honorable Patrisha Kaye N. Asugas was recorded. The body also noted that Honorable Roger L. Acedillo, and Honorable Ariel J. Lim, Jr., were both on leave.

READING AND APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF THE 21ST REGULAR SESSION:

At the instance of the Honorable Floor Leader, the body dispensed with the Reading of the Minutes of the 21st Regular Session held on January 14, 2026. Thereafter, with the presentation of a formal motion for its adoption and there being no comments or discussions from the floor, the said minutes was approved as presented.

FIRST READING & REFERRAL TO COMMITTEES:

The herein items calendared for First Reading and Referral to Committees were then taken up and acted upon accordingly, to wit:

1. First taken up were the following documents which were deemed noted and to be put on file. Along with such action, copies of the same are to be furnished to all SP Members, viz:
 - Letter-Invitation from the National Movement of Young Legislators (NMYL), relative to the holding of its 27th National Convention and Election of the National Executive Committee on February 23 to 25, 2026 at the Manila Hotel, 1 Rizal Park, Ermita, Manila.
 - Letter-Invitation from the Philippine Councilors League (PCL), relative to the 2026 National Congress & First Quarterly Continuing Local Legislative Education Program (CLLEP) on March 4-6-, 2026 at the World Trade Center, Pasay City.

2. Likewise, the following matters were deemed noted and to be put on file, to wit:
 - Endorsed machine copy of Memorandum from the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), dated January 9, 2026, re: Streamlined Guidelines for the projects (EIPs).
 - Resolution No. 12-493-2025 from the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Zamboanga del Sur, entitled: “Adopting the findings and recommendation embodied in Committee Report No. 300-2025, dated 11 December 2025 of the Committee on Infrastructure, Public Works & Highways, Community Development and Land Use, thereby declaring valid City Ordinance No. 2025-616 dated 12 November 2025 of Pagadian City, Zamboanga del Sur, entitled: “An Ordinance Mandating The Immediate Removal Of Excavated Materials, Waste And Excess Materials In Connection With Construction Activities Along Public Roads, Requiring The Installation Of Project Information Billboards For Government-Implemented Infrastructure Projects, And Imposing Administrative Sanction For Violations Thereof.”
3. The following items were referred to the Committee on Laws, Rules & Policy Formulation of the following items, viz:
 - Endorsed Contract of Affiliation to be entered into by and between the Pagadian City Health Office, represented by the Honorable City Mayor and Universidad de Zamboanga, Incorporated-Pagadian Campus through the Nursing Department, represented by Abram M. Eustaquio, MBA, relative to the Renewal of Affiliation and Training of Bachelor of Science in Nursing Students, with a request of the Honorable City Mayor, for an authority to enter into the same.
 - Endorsed request of the Honorable City Mayor for an authority to enter into Memorandum of Agreement with J.H. Cerilles State College (JHCSC), represented by Dr. Edgardo H. Rosales, JD, relative to the training, immersion, and/or internship of the school’s Nursing Students at the City Health Office.

UNSCHEDULED MATTERS:

At this juncture, the body then proceeded to tackle the individual concerns of the Council Members under Unscheduled Matters, these were then accorded actions as herein recorded, to wit:

- 1) Honorable Revelo presented the endorsed Board Resolution No. 01-03, series of 2026, from the Pagadian–Zamboanga del Sur Chamber of Commerce and Industry Foundation, Incorporated (PZCCIFI), entitled: “A Board Resolution respectfully requesting the Local Government Unit of Pagadian City to Grant an Extension of the Deadline for Business Permit Processing and Payment of Fees for Calendar Year 2026 until March 31, 2026. Following a brief deliberation, her subsequent motion and duly seconded led to the approval of the request through the passage of **Resolution No. 2026-0225**, approving the extension of the deadline for the renewal of local business permits from January 21, 2026 to March 31, 2026 and, for the purpose, shall condone such penalties and other charges that will be incurred due to the delayed or late payment thereof.
- 2) At this point, the body approved the motion for reconsideration made by Honorable Culve as it allows him to present Committee Report No. 091 from the Committee on Transportation, Road Traffic Management and Franchising, for Referral No. 15cc-0163. Following a brief recess to allow the Council Members discuss the matter informally, the body, after approving the amendment of the recommendation of the

concerned Committee, resolved to approve on First Reading Draft Ordinance No. 029, entitled: “An Ordinance approving the temporary road closure of portion of Dablo Street from corner Gov. Vicente Cerilles Street (formerly Alano Street) and Macaumbang Street every 2:00 o’clock in the afternoon up to 12:00 midnight from February 15, 2026 up to March 21, 2026, in connection with the celebration of the 1st PAgADIYAN Ramadan Food Festival and 4th Summit International Qur’an Reading with Islamic Symposium in observance of the 2026 Ramadan,” and for its consideration on Second Reading through the passage of **Resolution No. 2026-0226**.

Upon resumption after a brief recess, on motion of Honorable Culve and duly seconded, the body passed **Resolution No. 2026-0227**, approving on Second Reading Draft Ordinance No. 029, entitled: “An Ordinance approving the temporary road closure of portion of Dablo Street from corner Gov. Vicente Cerilles Street (formerly Alano Street) and Macaumbang Street every 2:00 o’clock in the afternoon up to 12:00 midnight from February 15, 2026 up to March 21, 2026, in connection with the celebration of the 1st PAgADIYAN Ramadan Food Festival and 4th Summit International Qur’an Reading with Islamic Symposium in observance of the 2026 Ramadan,” and for its consideration of the same on Third Reading.

After a recess was declared, upon formal motion of Honorable Culve and duly seconded, the body adopted **Resolution No. 2026-0228**, approving on Third and Final Reading Draft Ordinance No. 029 and ordaining the same as **City Ordinance No. 2026-625**.

- 3) Next considered was Committee Report No. 092 from the Committee on Finance and Appropriations, as presented by Honorable Bana, for Referral No. 15cc-0165, which led to the passage of **Resolution No. 2026-0229**, declaring Appropriation Ordinance No. 01, s. 2026 (Annual Budget) of the Sangguniang Barangay of Lison Valley, this city, to be operative and in full force and effect.
- 4) For Committee Report No. 093 from the Committee on Finance and Appropriations, as presented by Honorable Bana, for Referral No. 15cc-0166, the body enacted **Resolution No. 2026-0230**, declaring Appropriation Ordinance No. 01, s. 2026 (Annual Budget) of the Sangguniang Barangay of Dao, this city, to be operative and in full force and effect.
- 5) Honorable Ronald Christopher Glenn L. Ariosa, for his part, presented the endorsed copy of a Deed of Exchange to be entered into by and between the City Government of Pagadian and the Department of Environment and Natural Resources–Provincial Environment and Natural Resources (DENR-PENRO) pertaining to Lot No. 223-part owned by the City Government of Pagadian and Lot Nos. 9812 and 2355, owned by the DENR-Regional Office IX–PENRO, with a request of the Honorable City Mayor for authority to enter into the same, and following his formal motion, the body resolved to jointly refer the same to the Committee on Planning & Landed Estates and Committee on Laws, Rules and Policy Formulation.
- 6) For the endorsed Application of Mrs. Rosario M. Tenajeros for Special Use Permit for a Resort of a parcel of land located at Barangay Datagan, this city, which is classified as Agriculture Zone pursuant to City Ordinance No. 2K1-194 otherwise known as the “Zoning Ordinance of 2001” as amended by City Ordinance No. 2K8-273, as presented by Honorable Ronald Christopher Glenn L. Ariosa, the body referred the same to the Committee on Planning & Landed Estates.
- 7) At the instance of Honorable Ma. Alicia Elena V. Ariosa, the endorsed Application of Dos Paulo Agri-Venture Incorporated, represented by Mr. Paul Cariaga Cabual, for Special Land Use Permit for the Proposed Tunnel Ventilated Poultry (Broiler) House

of a parcel of land located at Barangay Gubang, this city, which is classified as Agriculture Zone pursuant to City Ordinance No. 2K1-194 otherwise known as the “Zoning Ordinance of 2001” as amended by City Ordinance No. 2K8-273, was jointly referred to the Committee on Planning & Landed Estates; Committee on Laws, Rules & Policy Formulation; and Committee on Agriculture and Fishery.

- 8) The motion for reconsideration presented by Honorable Pulmones to allow her to present Joint Committee Report No. 094 from the Committee on Barangay Affairs and Committee on Police, Fire, Public Safety and Illegal Drugs Prevention, for Referral No. 15cc-0156, was approved by the body. Following the Committee’s recommendation, the body deemed noted and filed the same.
- 9) Next considered was Committee Report No. 095 from the Committee on Barangay Affairs, as presented by Honorable Pulmones, for Referral No. 15cc-0157, which led to the passage of **Resolution No. 2026-0231**, remanding, without action, to the Barangay Council of Santa Maria its Barangay Ordinance No. 01, s. 2025, entitled: “An Ordinance shall be known as the neglectation of barangay served summons for the intentional action and violating the Katarungan Pambarangay Justice System Proceeding in relation to R.A. Known as the Local Government Code of 1991 cited as Katarungan Pambarangay Justice System,” with a further advise to institute revisions/amendments to conform with local and national laws.
- 10) After reconsidering Committee Report No. 096 from the Committee on Barangay Affairs and Committee on Human Rights and Subanen/Muslim Community Affairs, as reported by Honorable Pulmones, for Referral No. 15cc-0158, the body, in support of the Committee’s recommendation, resolved to adopt **Resolution No. 2026-0232**, remanding, without action, to the Barangay Council of Santa Maria its Barangay Ordinance No. 02, s. 2025, entitled: “An Ordinance Establishing the Office of the Barangay Human Rights Action Center (BHRAC) at Barangay Santa Maria, Pagadian City and Appropriating Funds,” with a further advise to incorporate necessary provisions mandated by law.
- 11) The body noted the information provided by the Secretary to the Sangguniang Panlungsod, in response to the query of Honorable Obaob, that letter-invitation for the presence and attendance of the members of the Board of Directors of the Pagadian City Water District had already been forwarded to their office as well as the approved resolution of the body which requested for copies of the 2nd Performance Evaluation on the PAMANA, but no response yet had been received by the Office of the Secretary to the Sanggunian. He further informed the body that an instruction had already been given to the office staff to make a follow up on that particular matter.

ADJOURNMENT:

With no more matters to discuss, the session was declared adjourned on motion of Honorable Bana, following the closing prayer led by Honorable Obaob.
