**MINUTES OF THE 24TH REGULAR SESSION OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD
(15TH CITY COUNCIL) OF PAGADIAN CITY HELD ON 04 FEBRUARY 2026 AT THE SP
SESSION HALL, 4TH FLOOR CITY COMMERCIAL CENTER (C3) BUILDING, PAGADIAN
CITY**

CALL TO ORDER:

Honorable Vice Mayor Monique Shaira Y. To, Presiding Officer, convened and officially called to order the 24th Regular Session of the 15th City Council at 9:37 in the morning.

INVOCATION, SINGING OF THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL ANTHEM AND RECITATION OF THE “PANUNUMPA SA WATAWAT NG PILIPINAS:

Upon motion of the Floor Leader, Honorable Jackielyn Krystyl C. Bana, the session, accompanied by a prepared audio recording, commenced with the invocation, followed thereafter by the mass singing of the Philippine National Anthem, the recitation of the “Panunumpa sa Watawat ng Pilipinas,” the singing of both the “Zamboanga del Sur March” and the “Pagadian City Hymn.”

ROLL CALL AND DETERMINATION OF QUORUM:

A roll call was made at the direction of the Chair and quorum was then declared with the attendance of seven (7) Council Members namely: Honorable Vice Mayor Monique Shaira Y. To, Honorable Roger L. Acedillo, Honorable Jackielyn Krystyl C. Bana, Honorable Ma. Alicia Elena V. Ariosa, Honorable Ann Marjorie N. Revelo, Honorable Maphilindo Q. Obaob, and Honorable Ronald Christopher Glenn L. Ariosa.

Honorable Bienvenido C. Culve, being the Officer In-Charge of the Office of the City Mayor, is considered present pursuant to Section 1, Rule IV of City Ordinance No. 2025-611.

Sometime later on during the course of the proceeding, the presence of Honorable Patrisha Kaye N. Asugas, and Honorable Marylynn U. Tan were recorded. The body also noted that Honorable Ariel J. Lim, Jr., and Honorable Joan Szanne S. Pulmones were both on leave, while Honorable Lance Samuel F. Co is absent.

READING AND APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF THE 23RD REGULAR SESSION:

At the instance of the Honorable Floor Leader, the body dispensed with the Reading of the Minutes of the 23rd Regular Session held on January 28, 2026. Thereafter, with the presentation of a formal motion for its adoption and there being no comments or discussions from the floor, the minutes was approved as presented.

FIRST READING & REFERRAL TO COMMITTEES:

The herein items calendared for First Reading and Referral to Committees were then taken up and acted upon accordingly, to wit:

1. The following documents from the barangays were referred to the Committee on Finance & Appropriations, to wit:
 - Resolution No. 97, s. 2026 from the Barangay Council of Lower Sibatang, entitled: “A resolution confirming the implementation of reenacted budget from January to December 2025 using the approved of the Lower Sibatang Annual Budget Calendar Year 2024.

- Appropriation Ordinance No. 01, s. 2026 (Annual Budget) of Barangay Danlunan, involving an appropriation of Nine Million Three Hundred Thousand Pesos (P9,300,000.00).
2. The endorsed Pro-forma Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to be entered into by and among the City Government of Pagadian, the Department of Social Welfare and Development, Field Office-IX, and the Western Mindanao State University-Pagadian External Campus, relative to the implementation of the “TARA BASA!” Tutoring Program, with a request of the Honorable City Mayor for an authority to enter into the same was referred to the Committee on Laws, Rules & Policy Formulation.
 3. Resolution No. 12-624-2026 from the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Zamboanga del Sur, entitled: “Adopting the findings and recommendation embodied in Committee Report No. 393-2026 dated 21 January 2026 of the Committee on Fire, Public Safety, Peace and Order, thereby declaring valid City Ordinance No. 2025-619 dated 26 November 2025 of Pagadian City, Zamboanga del Sur, entitled: “An Ordinance Creating The City Disaster Risk Reduction And Management Office As A Department Of The City Government Of Pagadian, Adopting Its Organizational Structure With Corresponding Positions And Staffing Pattern And Providing The Necessary Funds Therefor” was deemed noted and to be put on file.
 4. A referral was made for the endorsed letter of Ms. Jian Krezchel Consolacion, Governor, College of Business Education, Saint Columban College, Pagadian City, requesting for the temporary road closure of one side of the road adjacent to Saint Columban College from February 8–13, 2026 to accommodate the preparations for the forthcoming TABO 2026 Celebration, to the Committee on Transportation, Road Traffic Management and Franchising.
 5. The endorsed letter from Mr. Vener L. Dilig, OIC-Regional Executive Director, Department of Agriculture–Regional Field Office IX, re: Department Circular No. 1, s. 2026, informing all Local Government Units (LGUs) of the imposition of the moratorium on the issuance of Department of Agriculture (CA) Certification on Land-Use Reclassification was deemed noted and to be put on file. Along with such action, a copy of the same is to be furnished to all SP Members for their information and ready reference.
 6. Next considered was the letter–appeal from Ms. Aileen S. Sarcina, OIC–City Treasurer, for reconsideration of the approval of SP Resolution No. 2026-0225, which in gist, extend the deadline for the renewal of Local Business/Mayor’s Permit and the payment of Local Business Tax from January 20, 2026 to March 31, 2026, without incurring any penalties or surcharges thereof,” with a strong recommendation that the extension instead shall be up to February 28, 2026.

Upon resumption, following a huddle from the Council Members, the body, upon motion of Honorable Revelo and duly seconded, resolved to jointly refer the matter to the Committee on Commerce, Trade & Industry & Economic Enterprise & Cooperatives; and Committee on Ways & Means.

7. For the Veto Message of the Honorable City Mayor relative to the passage of City Ordinance No. 2026-625, entitled: “An Ordinance Approving The Temporary Road Closure Of Portion Of Dablo Street From Corner Gov. Vicente Cerilles Street (Formerly Alano Street) And Macaumbang Street Every 2:00 O’CLOCK In The Afternoon Up To 12:00 Midnight From February 15, 2026 Up To March 21, 2026, In Connection With The Celebration Of The 1st Pagadiyan Ramadan Food Festival And 4th Summit International Qur’an Reading With Islamic Symposium In

Observance Of The 2026 Ramadan,” for reasons specified thereat, the Chair declared a recess to allow the Council Members discuss the matter informally.

Upon resumption of the session, the body, following the manifestation of the Honorable Floor Leader that the veto of the Honorable City Mayor was anchored mainly on the General Welfare Clause specifically on the grounds of peace and order, security, traffic, safety and sanitation, resolved to lay the matter on the table.

UNSCHEDULED MATTERS:

The body considered the items under Unscheduled Matters which were meted the following actions, viz:

- 1) At this juncture, the body, on motion of Honorable Bana and duly seconded, reconsidered the earlier action of the body pertaining to Item No. F-5.3, the endorsed letter of Ms. Jian Krezchel Consolacion, Governor, College of Business Education, Saint Columban College, Pagadian City, requesting for the temporary road closure of one side of the road adjacent to Saint Columban College from February 8–13, 2026 to accommodate the preparations for the forthcoming “TABO 2026” Celebration which was referred to the Committee on Transportation, Road Traffic Management and Franchising.

Following the suspension of the rules, Ms. May Ann Langam, representative of the College of Business Education–Saint Columban College, was recognized as she extended her apologies for the delay in their request. She also ventilated their request for the temporary closure of the afore-cited portion of the road. After a brief deliberation, the body, on motion of the Honorable Floor Leader and duly seconded, adopted **Resolution No. 2026-0239**, approving on First Reading Draft Ordinance No. 030, entitled: “An Ordinance Approving The Temporary Closure To Vehicular Traffic Of Gov. Vicente M. Cerilles Street (Half Lane), Specifically Fronting The Saint Columban College From Corners Sanson Street And V. Sagun Street, from February 8-13, 2026, In Connection With The Saint Columban College “Tabo 2026” Activity,” and for its consideration on Second Reading.

Upon resumption after a brief recess, the formal motion of Honorable Bana and duly seconded facilitated the passage of **Resolution No. 2026-0240**, approving on Second Reading Draft Ordinance No. 030, entitled: “An Ordinance Approving The Temporary Closure To Vehicular Traffic Of Gov. Vicente M. Cerilles Street (Half Lane), Specifically Fronting The Saint Columban College From Corners Sanson Street And V. Sagun Street, from February 8-13, 2026, In Connection With The Saint Columban College “Tabo 2026” Activity,” and for the consideration of the same on Third Reading.

After another recess was declared, the body, upon formal motion of Honorable Bana and duly seconded, adopted **Resolution No. 2026-0241**, approving Draft Ordinance No. 030 on Third and Final Reading and Denominating the same as **City Ordinance No. 2026-626**, entitled: “An Ordinance Approving The Temporary Closure To Vehicular Traffic Of Gov. Vicente M. Cerilles Street (Half Lane), Specifically Fronting The Saint Columban College From Corners Sanson Street And V. Sagun Street, From February 8-13, 2026 In Connection With The Saint Columban College “Tabo 2026” Activity.

- 2) Committee Report No. 099 from the Committee on Finance & Appropriations, as reported by Honorable Bana, for Referral No. 15cc-0139, led to the passage of **Resolution No. 2026-0241**, approving and adopting the Supplemental Annual Investment List (SAIL) No. 1, Calendar Year 2025, of the City

Government of Pagadian involving priority and identified development programs and project under specific project location/area and with new Annual Investment Plan (AIP) Reference Code Number for clarification, transparency and project implementation to taken from AIP Reference Code No. DF25-8000-A5-a, Construction/Concreting/Improvement of Various Barangay Projects, in the total amount of Forty-Two Million One Hundred Thousand Pesos (P42,100,000.00), as herein enumerated, viz:

- 3) Committee Report No. 100 from the Committee on Finance & Appropriations, as reported by Honorable Bana, for Referral No. 15cc-0172 led to the approval of **Resolution No. 2026-0242**, declaring Appropriation Ordinance No. 01, s. 2026 (Annual Budget) of Barangay San Pedro, this city, to be operative and in full force and effect.
- 4) Lastly, Draft Resolution No. 020, authored by Honorable Revelo, entitled: “A Resolution directing the conduct of an inquiry, in aid of legislation, regarding the increase in parking fee tickets at the Pagadian City Airport, particularly the discrepancy between the approved amount of P22.40 and the P50.00 amount stamped on parking fee tickets, and to determine whether the increase of P27.60 is duly sanctioned by the Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines (CAAP) was presented. Following a brief deliberation with a visual presentation, the body, in support thereof, approved the said Draft Resolution No. 020 and thereafter referred the same jointly to the Committee

on Ways & Means; and Committee on Transportation, Road Traffic Management and Franchising.

ADJOURNMENT:

With no more matters to discuss, the session was declared adjourned on motion of Honorable Bana, following the closing prayer led by Honorable Asugas.
