



MINUTES OF THE 43RD REGULAR SESSION OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD (15TH CITY COUNCIL) OF PAGADIAN CITY HELD ON 15 JULY 2026 AT THE SP SESSION HALL, 4TH FLOOR CITY COMMERCIAL CENTER (C3) BUILDING, PAGADIAN CITY

CALL TO ORDER:

Honorable Vice Mayor Monique Shaira Y. To, Presiding Officer, convened and officially called to order the 43rd Regular Session of the 15th City Council at 9:25 in the morning.

INVOCATION, SINGING OF THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL ANTHEM AND RECITATION OF THE "PANUNUMPA SA WATAWAT NG PILIPINAS:

At the request of the Assistant Floor Leader, Honorable Ma. Alicia Elena V. Ariosa, the session, accompanied by a prepared audio recording, commenced with the invocation, followed thereafter by the mass singing of the Philippine National Anthem, the recitation of the "Panunumpa sa Watawat ng Pilipinas," the singing of both the "Zamboanga del Sur March" and the "Pagadian City Hymn."

ROLL CALL AND DETERMINATION OF QUORUM:

A roll call was made at the direction of the Chair and quorum was then declared with the attendance of eight (8) Council Members, namely: Honorable Vice Mayor Monique Shaira Y. To, Honorable Roger L. Acedillo, Honorable Ma. Alicia Elena V. Ariosa, Honorable Maphilindo Q. Obaob, Honorable Bienvenido C. Culve, Honorable Ronald Christopher Glenn L. Ariosa, Honorable Joan Szanne S. Pulmones, and Honorable Marylynn U. Tan.

Sometime later on during the course of the proceeding, the presence of Honorable Lance Samuel F. Co, Honorable Patrisha Kaye N. Asugas, and Honorable Ariel J. Lim, Jr., were recorded as acknowledged by the Chair. The body also noted that Honorable Jackielyn Krystyl C. Bana and Honorable Ann Marjorie N. Revelo were both on leave.

READING AND APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF THE 42ND REGULAR SESSION:

At the instance of the Floor Leader, the body dispensed with the Reading of the Minutes of the 42nd Regular Session held on July 8, 2026. Thereafter, with the presentation of a formal motion for its adoption and there being no comments or discussions from the floor, the minutes was approved as presented.

FIRST READING & REFERRAL TO COMMITTEES:

The herein items calendared for First Reading and Referral to Committees were then taken up and acted upon accordingly, to wit:

1. The following ordinances enacted by the Barangay Council of Bulatok were first taken up and was subsequently referred to the Committee on Barangay Affairs, as follows:

- Barangay Ordinance No. 1, s. 2026 from the Barangay Council of Bulatok, entitled: "An Ordinance Establishing A Barangay Residency Verification And Transient Registration System, Providing For The Registration Of Tenants, Boarders, Transient Occupants, And Other Temporary Residents, Prescribing Guidelines For The Issuance Of Barangay Residency Certifications, And For Other Purposes."
- Barangay Ordinance No. 4, s. 2026 from the Barangay Council of Bulatok, entitled: "An Ordinance Establishing A Barangay Rental, Boarding House, Apartment, Dormitory, And Transient Occupancy Registration System, Providing Guidelines For The Registration Of Lessors, Landlords, Boarding House

1 Operators, Tenants, Boarders, And Transient Occupants, And For Other
2 Purposes.”

3 2. Next referral was to the Committee on Public Utilities and
4 Communication/Information Technology, for the following Barangay Ordinances, to

7 entitled: “An Ordinance Promoting Responsible Use Of Social Media, Protecting
8 The Community Against False Public Safety Information, Establishing A Barangay
9 Online Dispute Assistance Mechanism, And For Other Purposes.”

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11 ➤ Barangay Ordinance No. 3, s. 2026 from the Barangay Council of Bulatok,
12 entitled: “An Ordinance Establishing The Digital Barangay Governance System Of
13 Barangay Bulatok, Providing For The Digitalization Of Barangay Records, Online
14 Public Services, Electronic Document Management, Digital Transparency
15 Mechanisms, And Other Related Purposes.”

16 3. A joint referral was also made to the Committee on Barangay Affairs and Committee
17 on Disaster/Calamity Resilience and Management Barangay Ordinance No. 5, s. 2026
18 from the Barangay Council of Bulatok, entitled: “An Ordinance Establishing The
19 Barangay Disaster Resilience, Climate Change Adaptation, And Community
20 Emergency Preparedness Program Of Barangay Bulatok, Providing For Community-
21 Based Disaster Risk Reduction And Management, Climate Adaptation Measures,
22 Emergency Response Preparedness, And For Other Purposes.”

23 4. Barangay Ordinance No. 6, s. 2026 from the Barangay Council of Bulatok, entitled:
24 “An Ordinance Establishing A Barangay Solid Waste Management And Plastic
25 Reduction Program, Prescribing Rules On Waste Segregation At Source, Regulating
26 The Use Of Single-Use Plastics In Barangay-Initiated Activities, And Strengthening
27 Community Participation In Environmental Protection” was referred jointly to the
28 Committee on Environment Protection, Ecological Preservation and Sanitation and
29 Committee on Health and Social Services.

30 5. A joint referral was made for Barangay Ordinance No. 7, s. 2026 from the Barangay
31 Council of Bulatok, entitled: “An Ordinance Prescribing Guidelines For The Issuance
32 Of Certifications Relating To Katarungang Pambarangay Records, Pending Barangay
33 Complaints, Compliance With Barangay Proceedings, Good Standing In Barangay
34 Proceedings, And Other Related Certifications, And Providing For The Denial Of
35 Requests For Certifications Contrary To Official Records” to the Committee on Laws,
36 Rules & Policy Formulation and Committee on Barangay Affairs.

37 6. At this juncture, the herein Barangay Ordinances were jointly referred to the
38 Committee on Barangay Affairs and Committee on Laws, Rules & Policy Formulation,
39 to wit:

40 ➤ Barangay Ordinance No. 8, s. 2026 from the Barangay Council of Bulatok,
41 entitled: “An Ordinance Establishing A Barangay Residency Verification Through
42 Community Verification Slid And Other Lawful Means Of Verification Prior To The
43 Issuance Of Barangay Certifications And Other Official Barangay Documents, And
44 For Other Purposes.”

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46 ➤ Barangay Ordinance No. 9, s. 2026 from the Barangay Council of Bulatok,
47 entitled: “An Ordinance Establishing Guidelines On The Recording Of Non-
48 Appearance In Katarungang Pambarangay Proceedings And The Issuance Of
49 Certifications Relating To Barangay Dispute Records.”

50 ➤ Barangay Ordinance No. 10, s. 2026 from the Barangay Council of Bulatok,
51 entitled: “An Ordinance Authorizing The Lease, Rental, And Use Of Barangay-

Owned Facilities, Utilities, Equipment, Machineries, And Other Barangay Properties, Prescribing Guidelines For Their Use; Providing For The Collection Of Rentals, Fees, And Other Charges Through Official Receipts; Requiring The Execution Of Written Contracts Of Lease Or Use Property Management Committee; And For Other Purposes.”

7. The Draft Ordinance No. 042, authored by Honorable Monique Shaira Y. To, entitled: “An Ordinance Creating One (1) Position Of Board Secretary IV, And Two (2) Positions Of Board Secretary III In The Office Of The Secretary To The Sangguniang Panlungsod Of Pagadian City, Prescribing Their Salary Grades, And Appropriating Funds Therefor” was referred to the Committee on Good Government, Ethics and Civil Service.

8. For SK Resolution No. 25, s. 2026 of the Sangguniang Kabataan of Barangay Gatas, entitled: “A resolution approving the SK Supplemental Budget No. 01, of Barangay Gatas, Pagadian City for the Priority Programs, Projects, and Activities (PPAs) related to sports development activities” the body resolved to refer the same to the Committee on Finance & Appropriations.

OTHER MATTERS:

In considering the documents calendared under Other Matters, the herein actions were recorded as unanimously adopted by the body to officially dispose of the items, to wit:

1. Honorable Lance Samuel F. Co presented the endorsed request of the Honorable City Mayor for authority to enter into a Usufruct Agreement with the Philippine Football Federation (PFF) relative to a City Government-owned parcel of land situated at Barangay Santa Lucia, this city, purposely for the construction of an Artificial Football Turf. Following a brief deliberation, the body, after the rules were suspended to urgently consider the same and, upon his formal motion and duly seconded, approved the request through the passage of **Resolution No. 2026-0424**, authorizing the Honorable City Mayor to execute and sign, for and in behalf of the City Government of Pagadian, a Deed of Usufruct in favor of the Philippine Football Federation (PFF), through the Pagadian-Zamboanga del Sur-Sibugay Regional Football Association, with reference to a portion of a City Government-owned parcel of land, covered by Tax Declaration No. 2019-001679, containing an area of Five Thousand (5,000) Square Meter, situated at Barangay Sta. Lucia, Pagadian City, purposely for the development of a football facility.
2. While, the endorsed Memorandum from Regional Director Pablo L. Benitez, Jr., DILG-RO 9, addressed to the DILG Provincial Director, on the subject: Approved Request of Authority to Conduct Quasi-Judicial Functions Seminar, Sportsfest and Provincial Assembly of the Vice Mayor’s League of the Philippines–Zamboanga del Sur Provincial Chapter, was simply noted and filed with the directive to furnish all SP Members with the copy of the same.

ADJOURNMENT:

With no more matters to discuss, the session was declared adjourned on motion of Assistant Floor Leader, following the closing prayer led by Honorable Culve.
